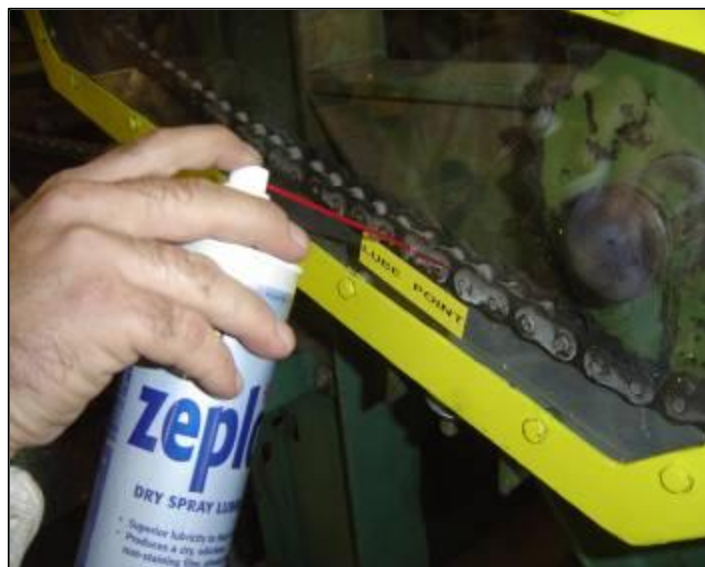

Are the drive chains loose, tight, dry, lubricated? Maintenance has to shut down and lock out the equipment to check. What if you had more than 200 of these drives? Would they get inspected in a timely manner? If not, you would be spending a lot of Maintenance dollars on worn sprockets, chains and downtime.

Installing lexan on the front of the chain cover, allows Maintenance or the Operator, to inspect the chains, while the equipment is running, and to lubricate the chains, while the equipment is running. This could be an Operator or Maintenance function. You decide, what makes sense in your facility with your equipment. No matter who does it, it will be safe, quick and easy to perform.
