Answer:

If our surveyors tiptoed very, very carefully, through every tulip of this 326.179 acre garden how many hectares would they be surveying?

Answer:

132 hectares

Statue of Liberty

If our surveyors looked at every bit of the 5.95 hectares of land, how many square feet would this be?

Answer:

640,452.7 ft²
